

# GMAT WAIVER REGULATIONS

*As a general policy, Goizueta Business School requires the GMAT of all applicants.*

*For the Modular Executive MBA Program beginning in Fall, and the Weekend Executive MBA Program beginning in January, the Office of Admissions will consider, on a case-by-case basis, GMAT waiver requests from candidates who fall into one of the categories identified. Waivers are not automatic for any candidate, and a brief written request must be submitted outlining the reasons why the Admissions Committee should grant a GMAT waiver.*

## CANDIDATES WHO MAY REQUEST A GMAT WAIVER ARE:

**A**) Those who hold the following graduate degrees from an accredited college or university with an overall grade point average of 3.0 or better (or the equivalent of a “B” average under the system used by that institution):

- A medical degree,
- A law degree,
- A masters or doctoral degree in an academic discipline that included a significant quantitative, engineering, mathematics, or statistics component,
- Any other quantitatively based graduate degree from an accredited college or university.

**B**) Those candidates who hold an undergraduate degree in a technical or quantitatively rigorous discipline (e.g., accounting, business, engineering, mathematics, physics, economics, chemistry) from an accredited institution and who graduated with an overall grade point average of 3.0 or better (or the equivalent of a “B” average under the system used by that institution).

**C**) Those candidates who can substantiate for the Admissions Committee through written documentation that the combination of their academic and professional experience makes them highly prepared for success in a quantitatively rigorous MBA Program.

## GMAT WAIVER REQUEST CHECKLIST

*The Admissions Committee will consider GMAT-waiver requests from candidates who wish to know whether the GMAT will be waived before submitting a completed application. The Admissions Committee will attempt to make all waiver decisions in a timely manner, but will require the following information before any decision is granted:*

A brief, one-page written request outlining the reasons why the Admissions Committee should grant a GMAT waiver, indicating which waiver category (A, B, or C) applies. This must be submitted (via either e-mail or regular mail) to Larisa Epshteyn, Executive MBA Admissions, at [larisa\\_epshteyn@bus.emory.edu](mailto:larisa_epshteyn@bus.emory.edu).

Copies of all transcripts for all work completed at any college or university, whether a degree was granted. Candidates may submit unofficial copies, but any unofficial copies must be followed by official transcripts submitted with the application.

A current resume outlining the specific job duties and functions of each position held after college graduation.
