## Concentration in Business Across Boundaries

The Business Across Boundaries joint concentration offers BBA students and Emory College students majoring in Interdisciplinary Studies (IDS) and American Studies (AMST) cross-fertilization experiences that will create connections and competencies critical to professional careers in for-profit and non-profit organizations, as well as in academia. In particular, this concentration will help students cross traditional boundaries and disciplines, to develop interdisciplinary knowledge and skills for creative, integrative analysis and problem-solving.

IDS and AMST students who complete this concentration will acquire grounding that will enable them to understand the functional areas of business, and how to utilize frameworks for effective stewardship of resources and the execution of strategies.

BBA students who complete this concentration will acquire a liberal arts grounding that will enable them to bring an interdisciplinary approach to analytic thinking, and skills in writing and communication that integrate multiple perspectives.

All students will have the opportunity to pursue industry-related electives drawn from business and interdisciplinary approaches.
