June 2	On-campus recruiting preferences – This is the first day that Employers can submit date preferences for on-campus visits via our recruiting platform https://goizueta.12twenty.com/hire

August 28	Recruiting Events Begin – This is the first day that Employers can begin to hold Company Presentations, Office Hours, and Off-Campus Events. Please work with your account manager to better understand what dates are ideal for your company's opportunity.
September 1	No Recruiting Activity – Labor Day Holiday
September 3	Resume Book Available – To receive a complementary Class of 2026 Resume Book, please contact your account manager.
September 5	Goizueta Career Connection (GCC) – GCC is our signature networking event that allows hundreds of students and company representatives to connect and begin building relationships. Company representatives will have the opportunity to meet with small rotating groups of First Year MBAs (Class of 2027) interested in your company.
